- supporting the inventor to write a full description of his invention
- searching relevant patents in databases to estimate the freedom of use and/or the patentability of the invention before applying a patent,
- checking the patent application written by the Patent Attorney,
- helping the IP manager to decide the foreign extensions of the new patent applications, and the renewal or withdrawal of existing patents,
- preparing answers to objections notified by official Patent Examiners of the various countries where the patent applications have been filed
