

**Application to change Study and Examination Regulations for the  
Bachelor's degree programme in International Business**

The new study and examination regulations ("SPO") for the Bachelor's degree programme in International Business will come into force in the winter semester 2022/2023. All students currently enrolled on the Bachelor's degree programme in International Business can transfer to the new SPO by submitting an application **between 01.10.2022 and 28.10.2022**.

Please note that any failed attempts in subjects other than the compulsory language modules will not be deleted but will remain.

**What has to be considered when changing study and examination regulations (SPO):**

- Applications can only be accepted **between 01.10.2022 and 28.10.2022**.
- Modules that have already been successfully completed will be recognised. This recognition does not have to be applied for separately. Failed examinations also remain in students' records. No grades will be deleted.
- Language modules that have already been completed and/or passed are shown as voluntary modules.
- **Language modules that have already been completed and/or passed can be deleted (e.g. because of a poor grade).**
- The transition will take place following the receipt of an application, from 01.10.2022 onwards.
- **The change to the new SPO is final and cannot be reversed!**
