

# International Business (IB) — Study Guidelines

#### Application for a Credit Transfer

- If you finished university before: submit recognition of your credit from previous studies by the application deadline.
- Application periods: 1–31 October and 15 March–15 April.
- The Examination Board makes the final admission decision.

### 🔣 Exam Rules

- By the end of Semester 2, you must attempt at least once:
  - Introduction to Management
  - o Intercultural Communication

Otherwise, it will count as your first failed attempt.

- All exams from Semesters 1–2 must be attempted by Semester 3 at the latest. Otherwise, it will count as your first failed attempt.
- To enter Study **Section 2** (Semesters 6–7), you must have:
  - Passed the modules from Semesters 1–3
  - o Earned at least 120 ECTS out of 150 from Semesters 1-5
- Specific prerequisite to note early: The exam Finance & Investment can only be taken after passing the PC-Internship(Training).

## Practical Semester

- Scheduled for Semester 6 (18 weeks).
- Cannot be in your home country and cannot be postponed to the last semester.
- Requirements:
  - o German A2 level
  - $\circ$  Completed modules of Semesters 1–3
  - $\circ$  At least 120 ECTS from Section 1
  - Make sure your contract and topic for practice project have been approved.
- Deadlines for Submitting Internship Contracts
  - O Winter-semester internship: submit by July 20 (latest).
  - Summer-semester internship: submit by January 15 (latest).
- Completion includes:
  - o Company certificate
  - Practice project
  - $\circ \quad \quad Colloquium$

## Bachelor's Thesis

- Written in English, normally after the practical semester.
- Duration: 5 months (+2 months extension possible with valid reason).
- To register a thesis topic, you must first complete 30 experimental hours as a participant in approved studies.

⚠ Start early to collect these hours and obtain the certificate as proof, keep all individual records safely (ideally in a digital folder), and present them to the Students` Office before registering your thesis.
