UARe@OTHAW- One-year scholarships for Ukrainian students

The Ostbayerische Technische Hochschule (OTH) Amberg-Weiden has successfully acquired funding for Ukrainian students within the framework of the DAAD funding program "Zukunft Ukraine - Scholarship Program for Refugees from Ukraine at German Universities". For the financial year 2023, OTH Amberg-Weiden will award one-year scholarships for up to seven enrolled Ukrainian students (see also faqs of the funding program).

The scholarship serves to finance full-time studies (Bachelor, Master, Ph.D.) at the OTH Amberg-Weiden. The scholarship is initially granted for one year and can be extended once (to a total of two years) upon application. The scholarship, which is paid out in twelve instalments, amounts to € 11,172 per year (€ 931 per month). Please be sure to read our important information below on the application procedure.

The aim of the one-year scholarship program is to promote and support Ukrainian students and young academics in Germany, i.e. Ukrainian citizens who had their center of life in Ukraine until 24.2.2022 and/or who came to Germany in the winter semester 21/22 to begin a degree program or an exchange semester, as well as third-country nationals or stateless persons who enjoy international protection in Ukraine, provided they were in Ukraine before or on 24.2.2022; more information on this can also be found in the FAQs of the "Zukunft Ukraine" DAAD funding program.

Notes on the application procedure:

Prerequisites for the awarding of the scholarship

- Enrolment as a student at the OTH Amberg-Weiden
- Complete application documents submitted in due time

Application documents to be submitted:

- completed and signed Declaration of Application
- current certificate of enrollment (Immatrikulationsbescheinigung) (WiSe 2022/23)
- Copy of an identification document (identity card/passport)
- Letter of motivation (approx. 1 DIN A4 page, max. 500 words)
- curriculum vitae

Application deadline (extended): January 15, 2023

→ Scholarship recipients are selected by a five-member jury. The decision of the jury is final. Legal recourse is excluded.

Important:

- Complete application documents must be submitted to KOMO (komo@oth-aw.de) by the deadline mentioned above. The deadlines are a cut-off period! Late and incomplete applications cannot be considered.
- Please note that parallel funding from several funding programs is not possible.
