UAre@OTHAW-Scholarships for Ukrainian students

The Ostbayerische Technische Hochschule (OTH) Amberg-Weiden has successfully acquired funding for Ukrainian students within the framework of the DAAD funding program "Zukunft Ukraine - Scholarship Program for Refugees from Ukraine at German Universities". OTH Amberg-Weiden will thus be able to award scholarships to enrolled Ukrainian students in 2023 and 2024.

The scholarship serves to finance full-time studies (Bachelor, Master, Ph.D.) at the OTH Amberg-Weiden. It is granted for the current funding period and can be extended for a further funding period if necessary, but not beyond 28.02.2025.

The amount of the scholarship is since 01.04.2024 934,-€ per month.
It is paid in monthly installments.

The aim of the one-year scholarship program is to promote and support Ukrainian students and young academics in Germany, i.e. Ukrainian citizens who had their center of life in Ukraine until 24.2.2022 and/or who came to Germany in the winter semester 21/22 to begin a degree program or an exchange semester, as well as third-country nationals or stateless persons who enjoy international protection in Ukraine, provided they were in Ukraine before or on 24.2.2022. Notes on the application procedure:

Prerequisites for the awarding of the scholarship

- Enrolment as a student at the OTH Amberg-Weiden
- Complete application documents submitted in due time

Application documents to be submitted (New application):

- curriculum vitae
- completed and signed Declaration of Application
- current certificate of enrollment (Immatrikulationsbescheinigung) (Winter semester 24/25) or confirmation of study place (Studienplatzzusage) (certificate of enrollment may have to be submitted later)
- Copy of an identification document (identity card / passport)
- Letter of motivation (approx. 1 DIN A4 page, max. 500 words)
Why are you applying for the scholarship? What do you study or intend to study at OTH Amberg-Weiden and how will the scholarship support you?

Application documents to be submitted (Extension):

- Transcript of records for the Summer Semester 2024 (can be submitted later)
- Expert opinion on the current course of studies by professor of OTH AW
- updated curriculum vitae, possibly information on changed personal circumstances

Applications for a scholarship can be submitted since 01.04.2024 at any time.

→ Scholarship recipients are selected by a five-member jury. The decision of the jury is final. Legal recourse is excluded.

Important:

- Awarded upon fulfilment of the award criteria and approval of the jury according to the receipt of applications and subject to the availability/exhaustion of funds.
- Please note that it is not possible to receive financial support from BAföG or other funding programs (such as ERASMUS+) and the DAAD scholarship at the same time. Income (gross) from an approved part-time job above 538 euros per month will be counted towards the scholarship.
